# The 7 Foundations of Jesus' Ministry

## 1. The Ministry and Work of the Spirit

The <u>Spirit of the Lord is upon me</u>, because <u>he has anointed me</u> to tell the good news to the destitute Luke 4:18a

## 2. The Ministry of Evangelism for Salvation

The Spirit of the Lord is upon me, because he has anointed me to <u>tell</u> the good news to the destitute Luke 4:18a

## 3. The Ministry of Inner Healing

...to heal the brokenhearted... Luke 4:18b

## 4. The Ministry of Deliverance

He has sent me to proclaim freedom to the <u>prisoners</u>... Luke 4:18c

#### 5. The Ministry of Revelation

recovering of sight to the blind... Luke 4:18d

## 6. The Ministry of Healing the Soul

...to set free the oppressed, Luke 4:18e

## 7. The Ministry of Proclaiming God's Grace

to proclaim the year of the Lord's favor." Luke 4:19

## Rejecting God's Word gives the enemy a place to torment and cause emotional wounds and feelings of abandonment.

## 7 Emotional Strongholds of a Broken Heart

## 1. Anger

- a. Exhibit explosive behavior
- b. Show uncontrollable rage

## 2. Insecurity

- a. Constantly need attention
- b. Concern where they sit in meetings
- c. Need to be recognized

#### 3. Pride

- a. Portray themselves of have it all together
- b. Talk a lot
- c. Often give their opinion about everything

## 4. Independence

- a. Do not need anyone
- b. Think they can make it on their own
- c. Do not listen to council

## 5. Easily Offended

- a. Take comments very personally
- b. Cannot joke with them

## 6. Isolation or Loneliness

- a. Withdraw from others
- b. Remove from fellowship
- c. Show excessive shyness

## 7. Control and Manipulation

- a. Interrupt a lot
- b. Get defensive
- c. Turn the tables on you ("You do the same thing")
- d. Have self-pity (feel sorry for themselves)
- e. Cry
