To Seek First His Kingdom and His Righteousness...

1. You must store up treasures in heaven.

¹⁹“Do not store up for yourselves treasures on earth, where moths and vermin destroy, and where thieves break in and steal. ²⁰But **store up** for yourselves **treasures in heaven**, where moths and rust do not destroy, and where thieves do not break in and steal. ²¹**For where your treasure is, there your heart will be also.** Matthew 6:19-21 NIV

Where is your treasure?

2. You must have heathy spiritual eyes.

²²“The eye is the lamp of the body. If your **eyes** are **healthy**, your whole body will be full of light. ²³But if your eyes are unhealthy, your whole body will be full of darkness. If then the light within you is darkness, how great is that darkness! Matthew 6:22-23 NIV

How heathy are your spiritual eyes?

3. You must serve only the King of Kings.

²⁴“**No one can serve two masters.** Either you will hate the one and love the other, or you will be devoted to the one and despise the other. You cannot serve both God and money [worldly riches]. Matthew 6:24 NIV

Which master are you serving?

4. You must trust your heavenly Father.

²⁵“**Therefore** I tell you, do not worry about your life, what you will eat or drink; or about your body, what you will wear. Is not life more than food, and the body more than clothes? ²⁶**Look** at the birds of the air; they do not sow or reap or store away in barns, and yet your heavenly Father feeds them. Are you not much more valuable than they?

²⁷Can any one of you by worrying add a single hour to your life?

²⁸“And why do you worry about clothes? **See** how the flowers of the field grow. They do not labor or spin. ²⁹Yet I tell you that not even Solomon in all his splendor was dressed like one of these. ³⁰If that is how God clothes the grass of the field, which is here today and tomorrow is thrown into the fire, will he not much more clothe you—you of little faith? ³¹So do not worry, saying, ‘What shall we eat?’ or ‘What shall we drink?’ or ‘What shall we wear?’ ³²For the pagans run after all these things, and your heavenly Father knows that you need them. ³³**But seek first his kingdom and his righteousness**, and all these things will be given to you as well. ³⁴Therefore do not worry about tomorrow, for tomorrow will worry about itself. Each day has enough trouble of its own. Matthew 6:19-34 NIV
