⁴⁴ "The kingdom of heaven is like <u>treasure hidden</u> in the <u>field</u>. 1. Jesus searches for us.

⁴⁴ "The kingdom of heaven is like <u>treasure hidden</u> in the <u>field</u>. Matthew 13:44a CET

⁴⁵**Again,** the kingdom of heaven is like a **merchant looking** for beautiful pearls. Matthew 13:45 CET

For the Son of Man came to seek and to save the lost." Luke 19:10 NIV

2. Jesus rejoices in finding us.

After a <u>person</u> found it, he hid it, and in his **joy**... Matthew 13:44b CET See Luke 15:6,9 and 24.

⁷ I tell you that in the same way, there will be *more* joy in heaven over one sinner who repents than over ninety-nine righteous people who have no need of repentance. Luke 15:7 NASB See also v.10.

3. Jesus chose and values us.

⁴⁶And after **he found one pearl** of **great worth**... Matthew 13:46a CET

¹⁸ "If the world hates you, keep in mind that it hated me first. ¹⁹ If you belonged to the world, it would love you as its own. As it is, you do not belong to the world, but I have **chosen** you out of the world. That is why the world hates you. John 15:18-19 NIV See 1 Thessalonians 1:4-6.

²⁶ Look at the birds of the air; they do not sow or reap or store away in barns, and yet your heavenly Father feeds them. Are you not <u>much</u> <u>more valuable</u> than they? Matthew 6:26 NIV See Isaiah 43:4.

4. Jesus gave everything for us.

he went and **sold everything** that he had and **bought that field**. Matthew 13:44c CET

he went away and sold everything he had and bought it." Matthew 13:46c CET

Keep watch over yourselves and all the flock of which the Holy Spirit has made you overseers. Be shepherds of the church of God, which he **bought** with his own blood. Acts 20:28 NIV

⁶ Who, being in very nature God, did not consider equality with God something to be used to his own advantage; ⁷ rather, **he made himself nothing by taking the very nature of a servant**, being made in human likeness... he humbled himself by becoming obedient to death— even death on a cross! Philippians 2:6-8 NIV

⁶ For you are a people holy to the LORD your God.
