# **CHRIST** is the Power and Wisdom of God! 1 Corinthians 2

[For Messiah sent me] to proclaim the Good News —not with wisdom and eloquence, lest the cross of Messiah be emptied of its power. <sup>18</sup> For the message of the cross is foolishness to those who are perishing, but to us who are being saved it is the power of God. 1 Corinthians 1:17-18 CET

<u>Jews demand signs and Greeks look for wisdom</u>, <sup>23</sup> but <u>we preach</u>
<u>Christ crucified</u>: a stumbling block to Jews and foolishness to
Gentiles, <sup>24</sup> but to those whom God has called, both Jews and Greeks,
<u>Christ the power of God and the wisdom of God</u>. 1 Corinthians 1:2224 NIV

<sup>28</sup> God chose the lowly things of this world and the despised things—and the things that are not—to nullify the things that are, <sup>29</sup> so that no one may boast before him. <sup>30</sup> It is because of him that you are in Christ <u>Jesus</u>, <u>who</u> <u>has become for us wisdom from God</u>—that is, our righteousness, holiness and redemption. <sup>31</sup> Therefore, as it is written: "Let the one who boasts boast in the Lord." 1 Corinthians 1:28-31 NIV

## 1. Godly Wisdom is **Demonstrated** by the Spirit's Power!

And so it was with me, brothers and sisters. When I came to you, I did not come with eloquence or human wisdom as I proclaimed to you the testimony about God. <sup>2</sup> For I resolved **to know** nothing while I was with you **except <u>Jesus Christ and him crucified</u>**. <sup>3</sup> I came to you in weakness with great fear and trembling. <sup>4</sup> My message and my preaching were <u>not with wise and persuasive words</u>, but <u>with a demonstration of the Spirit's power</u>, <sup>5</sup> so that <u>your faith might not rest on human wisdom</u>, but on **God's power**. 1 Corinthians 2:1-5 NIV

Have you experienced the Spirit's power in your life?

#### 2. God's Wisdom is **Experienced** among the Mature.

<sup>6</sup>We do, however, speak <u>a message of wisdom among the mature</u>, but not the wisdom of this age or of the rulers of this age, who are coming to nothing. <sup>7</sup>No, we <u>declare God's wisdom</u>, a mystery that has been <u>hidden</u> and that <u>God destined for our glory before time began</u>.

<sup>8</sup>None of the rulers of this age understood it, for if they had, they would not have **crucified the Lord of glory**. 1 Corinthians 2:6-8 NIV

How can you mature in your relationship with God?

#### 3. God's Wisdom is Revealed for Those Who Love Him.

<sup>9</sup> However, as it is written: "What no eye has seen, what no ear has heard, and what no human mind has conceived"—the things God has prepared for those who love him— <sup>10</sup> these are the things God has revealed to us by his Spirit. The Spirit searches all things, even the deep things of God. 1 Corinthians 2:9-10 NIV

#### How can you grow deeper in your love for God?

### 4. God's Wisdom is Taught by the Spirit.

<sup>12</sup> What we have received is not the spirit of the world, but the Spirit who is from God, so that we may understand what God has freely given us. <sup>13</sup> This is what we speak, not in words taught us by human wisdom but in words taught by the Spirit, explaining spiritual realities with Spirittaught words. 1 Corinthians 2:12-13 NIV

## 5. God's Wisdom is **Discerned** Only through the Spirit.

<sup>14</sup> The person without the Spirit does not accept the things that come from the Spirit of God but considers them foolishness, and cannot understand them because they are <u>discerned only through the Spirit</u>. <sup>15</sup> The person with the Spirit makes <u>judgments</u> about all things, but such a person is not subject to merely human judgments, <sup>16</sup> for, "Who has known the mind of the Lord so as to instruct him?" But we have <u>the mind of Christ</u>. 1 Corinthians 2:14-16 NIV

#### How can having the mind of Christ transform your life?

Therefore, I urge you, brothers and sisters, in view of God's mercy, to offer your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and pleasing to God—this is your true and proper worship. <sup>2</sup> Do not conform to the pattern of this world, but **be transformed by the renewing of your mind.** Then you will be able to test and approve what God's will is—his good, pleasing and perfect will. Romans 12:1-2 NIV
