The Lord is gracious and compassionate, slow to anger and rich in love. Psalm 145:8 NIV

The Lord longs to be gracious to you. Isaiah 30:18a NIV

What is Grace?

Grace is the unmerited, undeserved, unearned kindness and favor of God.

For the law was given through Moses; grace and truth came through Jesus Christ. John 1:17 ESV

Grace is a Gift from God!

For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God,²⁴ and are justified by his grace as a gift, through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus. Romans 3:23-24 ESV

For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith—and this is not from yourselves, it is the gift of God—⁹ not by works, so that no one can boast.¹⁰ For we are God's handiwork [masterpiece], created in Christ Jesus to do good works, which God prepared in advance for us to do. Ephesians 2:8-10 NIV

5. Motivates Us for Good Works.
